Ste Rose Hosting an "A Cappella Evening" Featuring Yale University Group

Ste. Rose de Lima Church is pleased to sponsor an "A Cappella Evening" **Sunday October 22, 2017 at 6:00pm**, at 600 Grattan Street, Chicopee. This event is free to the public. Donations will be accepted for the St Joan of Arc Elementary School Scholarship Fund. Yale University's Society of Orpheus and Bacchus will be performing songs from their latest album along with songs from their 79 year history, which span folk, jazz, pop, rock, and choral music. They are the second longest running collegiate a cappella group in America, having performed across the country and internationally since 1938.

The Increased Offertory Program

Many parishioners have responded to this appeal – thank you! Several families were able to pledge a weekly/monthly/yearly increase – thank you! Several families are able to maintain their present level of sacrificial giving – thank you! Several families who have not contributed in the past several months or years have decided to financially support the parish – thank you! In a very real way this campaign is to “Secure the Future” of this community of faith. The concept of “STEWARDSHIP” is one of being sacrificial with TIME, TALENT, and TREASURE to ensure the future viability of this wonderful faith community. As mentioned at the introduction of this program at Sunday Mass a few weekends ago, this is the first initiative undertaken in over 12 years. The only other capital campaigns that were conducted were to replace the church roof and organ. Finally, the parish has implemented this program at no cost. The Diocese has absorbed the cost at no hidden expense to the parish. The Bishop does not directly benefit from this increased level of contribution. Indirectly, the Diocese has a real benefit: The Diocese is only as healthy as is each of its parishes. What would Western Massachusetts be like if the Catholic Community simply disappeared? There would no longer be a Mass schedule to accommodate an equitable access to the Eucharist. Baptisms, Nuptial Masses, Liturgies of Christian Burial, and religious education whether it be a Catholic School or a CCD program would be rare though the need would be great. It’s not only about Catholicism. Christian communities of most major denominations are in a similar crisis. Smaller Christian communities are either merging or closing as well. Therefore, I am so grateful for your generous response. May Ste. Rose de Lima, our patroness, intercede on our behalf for the continued growth and love of our Catholic faith here in Aldenville.
