***Dear Parishioner...Around & About Ste. Rose,
The “scaffolding” on the Chapel Street Entrance***

Several years ago, the steeple of the church went through a \$250,000 renovation due to the aging of the brick and mortar. The steeple is still in very good condition; however, a small section of the “pre-cast/limestone” has shown deterioration due to water and wind on the front portion with little exposure to the sun to dry the stone. Pieces of stone have fallen from a very high section. The deterioration is limited. Because it is winter, repairs to the few sections of deterioration cannot be completed until springtime. The scaffolding has been installed with a “wooden shield” to prevent any serious injury by pieces that will most certainly fall. The scaffolding is simply a “safety measure” and will be uninstalled upon the completion of the needed repairs. It is completely safe to enter the church through the Chapel Street side-entrance. Thank you for your understanding on this “safety” concern.

The New Year is now into full swing. The holidays are now a wonderful memory. A simple reminder to all members of Ste. Rose that Bishop Rozanski will be here on a “pastoral visit” with a team of people to interview parishioners which will include volunteers, staff, Parish Council, and Finance Council. Bishop has made this pastoral visit to nearly every parish in the four counties of Western Massachusetts. It is his attempt to get to know the parish, school, cemetery, and its members in a very pastoral way.
