***Dear Parishioner...Around & About Ste. Rose,
Sacrificial Offering***

The Sacrificial Offering for Sunday, October 25, 2020 was \$6,202.00. Thank you for your spiritual and financial support.

The comparison of October 2019 versus October 2020 average of four weeks of Sacrificial Giving:

October 2019 = \$9,526.00 vs. October 2020 = \$8,217.00 for a weekly shortfall of **(\$1,309.00)**.

Loose cash for October 2019 = \$3,536.00. Loose cash for October 2020 = \$1,829.00. For a shortfall of **(\$1,707.00)**. The average loose cash for 10/2019 = \$884.00 vs average loose cash for 10/2020 = \$458.00. The difference weekly = **(\$427)** As you can see just by the loose cash totals, fewer persons are attending Mass due to the pandemic. Overall, while the income is down somewhat, given COVID 19, your generosity is very much appreciated. Thank you! Thank you! Thank you!

Veteran's Day is Wednesday, November 11th

Ste. Rose de Lima is pleased to host the 2020 *Veteran's Day Service* on behalf of the City of Chicopee. The service will be at 10:00 AM. All residents of the City of Chicopee are invited to participate in this ecumenical service to honor our American Veterans!

All Saints Day November 1st is a holyday of obligation. Because it falls on a Sunday this year there is no further obligation to attend a second Mass. ***All Souls' Day, November 2nd*** is not a holy day of obligation. Mass will be offered at 7:00 AM on Monday morning. This year with the "internet" Mass, All Souls' Day Intentions will be offered each Sunday of November. The All Souls' offering of names will be on the altar throughout the month of November.

The Annual Mass of Remembrance cannot be a public Mass this year due to the pandemic and also due to the significant number of people who passed into eternal life during this past year. However, The Mass of Remembrance will be recorded and uploaded to our website. The Mass will be recorded November 2, 2020. Pictures of the recent “limestone issue” where deterioration was in process on the steeple of the church

As the picture indicates the capstone was deteriorating above the screening where the church bells are housed and another spot to the right edge of the column. From that height the falling debris could potentially be life-threatening. It was so necessary to make that repair.

The picture below shows the workman working on patching both spots of deterioration. While the “boom” was on-sight, other patches where applied were “chaffing” was occurring. After the repair, an abundant coat of waterproofing was sprayed on the entire steeple.

One of the advantages of an “on-line” bulletin is that we can post pictures!!!! A picture is worth a thousand words. As you can see it was a perfect day to get the work done! Would you have liked to work at such heights? With the completion of this work, the “roofed staging” was removed. The safety hazard no longer exists.

And finally,

As the pandemic continues to “tick-up” globally, it is so important to continue to be vigilant with protocol for staying COVID free. Please wear masks while in public, frequent handwashing, getting a flu shot this year, and avoid large “gatherings.” Recent large gatherings appear to be a major cause of the resurgence of the

coronavirus. I believe that we are tiring of the protocols. However, it appears that a continued vigilance of protocol helps significantly with reducing the spread of this virus.

It has come to my attention that several parishes have resumed the customary way of receiving communion; that Holy Communion is distributed at the “normal time.” Communicants would return to the pews after reception, offer the Post Communion prayer, and finally the Dismissal. I will ask for a show of hands at all the Masses this weekend. Should the majority prefer the return to “normal,” it would be implemented November 5-6, 2020. The entrance and recessional processions would still be eliminated, however. While exiting the church after Mass, it would be very important to keep masks on and attempt to maintain social distancing.

Please remember to place the kneeler on the floor of the pew you used to indicate which pews need to be disinfected.


