**Dear Parishioner...Around & About Ste. Rose,
Sean Cardinal O'Malley**

As of June 19 & 20, Sean Cardinal O'Malley has lifted the dispensation from Sunday Mass attendance. Beginning this weekend, the obligation to attend Sunday Mass has returned. Sean Cardinal O'Malley's decision affects all dioceses in the Boston Province: Boston, Fall River, Worcester, Springfield as well as the dioceses in Vermont, Maine, and New Hampshire. If, however, there are extenuating health issues, the decision to either attend Mass or not attend Mass, is based upon an informed decision of each person.

Ste. Rose de Lima Parish

Ste. Rose has begun the "new normal" as the Commonwealth of Massachusetts has lifted COVID 19 restrictions. Churches are at 100% occupancy with no further restrictions. Practically, it means a return to Sunday Mass, daily Mass, Communion to the home-bound is restored, full Funeral Mass participation and Nuptial Mass participation, the celebration of Baptism, the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and the administration of the Sacrament of the Sick – formerly known as "The Last Rites." Nursing Homes and Medical Centers still have strict protocol for visitation of patients/residents; however, if there is a "life ending crisis" the priest can administer the sacraments. Should this be the case, please do not delay the call to the Pastoral Center. As the "great re-opening" continues, please remember the parish needs more volunteers in nearly every aspect of parish life. If you would be so generous as to offer some your time and talent for the benefit of parish life, just know that you are most welcome.

Bingo on Saturday evening!

Bingo is once again open for your enjoyment and for the benefit of St. Joan of Arc School. All receipts generated from Bingo are forwarded to SJA. So, help spread the news that bingo is reopened and rebuild the number of bingo patrons to the pre-pandemic level of 200-220. Again, volunteers are more than welcome to join the team and help support SJA School.
