In all of today’s readings, people hear the Lord calling them to service, and all of them change course to follow their vocation. Young or old, we all have the responsibility to listen for the Lord’s direction and answer with enthusiasm, as did Isaiah, Paul, Peter, James, and John.

### ***LITURGY OF THE WORD:***

Isaiah recounts his glorious vision of the Lord and his commissioning. Paul reminds the Corinthians of the Gospel he preached to them and lists the resurrected Jesus’ appearances, culminating in his own call and conversion. In the Gospel, after preaching from Simon’s fishing boat, Jesus tells him to *put out into deep water*. They catch a *great number of fish* and this leads Peter, James, and John to follow Jesus.
