This weekend's column is a bit of "This & That!"***

+ A simple reminder that next weekend the annual "Missionary Cooperative" collection will take place. Sr. Cindy Matthews will make the appeal for the St. Elizabeth Mission Society. Brochures about this missionary society are available in the foyer of the church. This will be a second collection.

+ As of July 1, 2022, 370 contributors donated \$47,455 to the 2022 Annual Catholic Appeal – thank you! It's never too late to contribute to this year's campaign. + Progress continues with the renovations in the church. Thanks for your opinions concerning this improvement. Again, this renovation is made possible from dividends and interest received from the parish investment fund. Please continue to support the parish weekly so that all recurring expenditures can be met; thereby preserving the dividends and interests to afford the costs of such renovations. The total cost of the work on the pews, kneelers, flooring, and painting is approximately \$200,000. Thank you for your support. Volunteers are needed to strip off the old kneeling covers in preparation for the new coverings. If you can put aside a few hours, your labor will assist in saving on the cost of this project.

+ This week, August 3 and 4, I will be away with family on the Cape. Morning Mass will be replaced by a scripture/communion service led by Deacon Michael Trznadel for these two mornings.

+ Pastoral visits to medical centers and other health care facilities are allowed; however, the general practice of doing "rounds" at these facilities is still not allowed if there is no COVID present in the patient.
