FOCUS: *God's call is an invitation to service, honor, and holiness.* Today's readings center on God's call. All of those called: Isaiah, Saint Paul, Sosthenes, and John the Baptist, have a special vocation from God to bear witness to his name and foster holiness among his people. God equips those so chosen with grace, honor, and strength to carry out their mission. He calls and equips us, too.

LITURGY OF THE WORD: Isaiah prophesies a servant who will restore Israel and be a *light to the nations.* In the second reading, Paul and Sosthenes send greetings *to the church of God that is in Corinth.* In the Gospel, John the Baptist sees Jesus and proclaims him to be the Lamb of God.
