***Dear Parishioner...Around and About Ste. Rose,
Holy Name of Jesus Parish to close June 30, 2023***

Bishop William D. Byrne announced his “prayerful” decision to close Holy Name of Jesus Parish effective June 30, 2023. Holy Name of Jesus was the first Catholic parish built from the Diocese of Boston in 1838. The church on South Street is not the original parish building. Eventually the existing structure was built. The parish church served the people of Holy Name until the Pastoral Plan was implemented. You may remember in 2009 The Catholic Community of Chicopee was reduced from 10 active parishes to 5 active parishes. A short time thereafter, the City of Chicopee determined that the parish church on South Street was unsafe due to termite damage that compromised the structural integrity of the building. With that determination, the diocese re-opened the Assumption of the BVM church building on Springfield Street as Holy Name of Jesus Parish. Since that time, much of the patrimony from the South Street location has been sold, emptying the church of its altars, etc.

The unfortunate reality of the Springfield Street location is that the building is riddled with deferred maintenance issues; the building needs repairs that are beyond the parish’s ability to afford. The parish also fell into irreversible debt. As Deacon David Southworth mentioned in *The Republican* “Bishops do not close parishes, people do with their lack of Mass attendance and financial support.” Now, the Catholic Community of Chicopee will be reduced to 4 active parishes. There are now the following buildings that will stand dormant and continue to deteriorate: Holy Name, Assumption, St. George, and St. Patrick.

Ste. Rose de Lima Parish will be possibly one of the parishes that members of Holy Name may be interested in becoming members. Inquiries have already begun. Members of Holy Name who are involved in ministries may be interested in ministries here. All Holy Name members will be most welcome to Ste. Rose de Lima Parish. Let us keep the members of Holy Name Parish in our thoughts and prayers during these 120 remaining days.

Over the past 17 plus years, Ste. Rose de Lima’s campus has been under continuous repair and renovation. “Our” buildings are in very good condition but this has come at a great expense. However, if the infrastructure of our campus were to have continued “deferred” maintenance, Ste. Rose could have been in a similar situation of enormous costs to secure building integrity. As Deacon Southworth said: ““Bishops do not close parishes, people do with their lack of Mass attendance and financial support.”” For Ste. Rose de Lima to remain open for decades to come, the membership of the parish must continue to celebrate the Eucharist and employ the true theme of Stewardship: TIME, TALENT, and TREASURE. May God bless our parish community and may Ste. Rose de Lima, our patroness, intercede on our behalf for decades to come.

LENTEN REGULATIONS:

1/ Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of abstinence from meat as well as days of fast, when only one full meal is allowed. +On days of fast, two other meatless meals may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal.

2/ The other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat.

3/ The obligation to abstain from meat begins at fourteen (14) years of age.

4/ The obligation to fast begins at eighteen (18) years of age and ends at fifty-nine (59) years of age.

5/ Although the faithful may excuse themselves for a just cause from these laws of fast and abstinence, there is an obligation to substitute another penance and no Catholic should lightly excuse himself/herself from this obligation in the Lenten Season.
