***Missionary Cooperative Plan: Medical Missionaries of Mary***

Each year the Society for the Propagation of the Faith assigns a mission society to solicit funding for their respective missionary charism. The Medical Missionaries of Mary are trained as nurses, midwives, doctors, social workers, pharmacists, pastoral workers counselors, and administrators. With these skills they bring compassionate healing and true human development to those on the margins of society: the sick and the poor, including mothers and children, persons living with HIV/AIDS, and those persons in danger of being caught up in human trafficking. ***Ste. Rose Cemetery***

In the very near future the columbarium project will be completed and readied for the sale of individual niches for the inurnment of cremains. A columbarium is an above-ground structure for the burial of cremains only. There will be four columbaria with each columbarium having 24 niches with the original construction. Each niche will be able to accommodate 2 urns. In total there will be available for purchase 96 niches with the capacity of inurning 192 urns. Upon reaching the 70% sale mark of these 96 niches, other columbaria will be built for the continual development of the columbarium site. The site is located to the far-left side of the cemetery, along the Schoolhouse Road section. The cemetery is preparing all the needed paperwork and pricing plan for purchase very soon. Cremation is trending toward 60%-70% versus the traditional full-body burial. By building a columbarium section, Ste. Rose Cemetery is providing options for the sacred inurnment of the cremains of our beloved dead. Cremains will still be able to be buried in existing graves. The rule is two (2) inurnments per one full body grave. For each inurnment in an existing grave there is a re-use fee and an opening fee.
