FOCUS: *The kingdom of heaven is at hand.*

God's heart has been *moved with pity* for us throughout salvation history. God sees us in our wanderings, like sheep without a shepherd. Our readings today weave together a tender saga of God's loving care as he works to gather us back unto himself.

LITURGY OF THE WORD: In the first reading, God reminds the Israelites of his care, exhorts them to keep his covenant, and promises to make them *a kingdom of priests, a holy nation*. In Paul's Letter to the Romans, we are reminded that we were reconciled while we were still helpless, through Christ. In the Gospel, Jesus is moved with pity and sends his disciples to heal and preach.
