


COFFEE & DONUTS

**ST. ROSE DE LIMA CEMETERY
RULES & REGULATIONS**

(FOR THE SAFETY OF OUR WORKERS & VISITORS)



- † Flowers allowed from May 15—June 25
- † Winter decorations allowed from Dec 1– March 15
- † After these dates, only one (1) pot of flowers per lot
- † No artificial flowers
- † No urns, metal planters, flag holders, glass containers, stones or vigil lights
- † No planting flowers, trees or shrubs/bushes in the earth
- † No pets allowed
- † Cemetery closes at dusk

(Hazards—glass breaking and falling in grass can become a projectile object with the mowers. Artificial decorations can get caught up in the blades of the mowers. Pots or objects placed on the ground in front of the stones hinder the crew from cleaning close to the stones while weed whacking or mowing.)

We try to maintain the beauty of the cemetery for all loved ones. Please help us assure proper & safe maintenance by following these regulations. Thank you!
